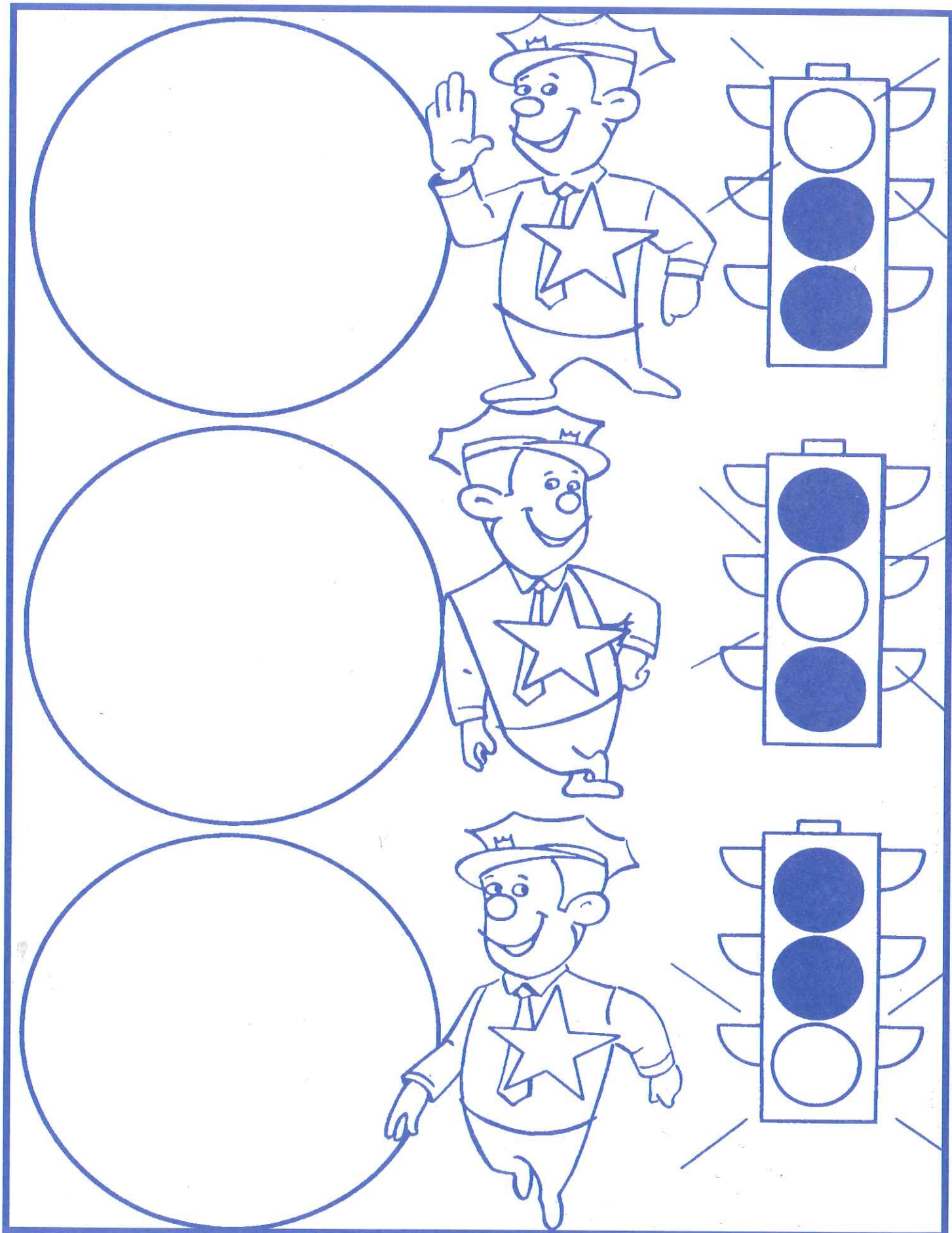

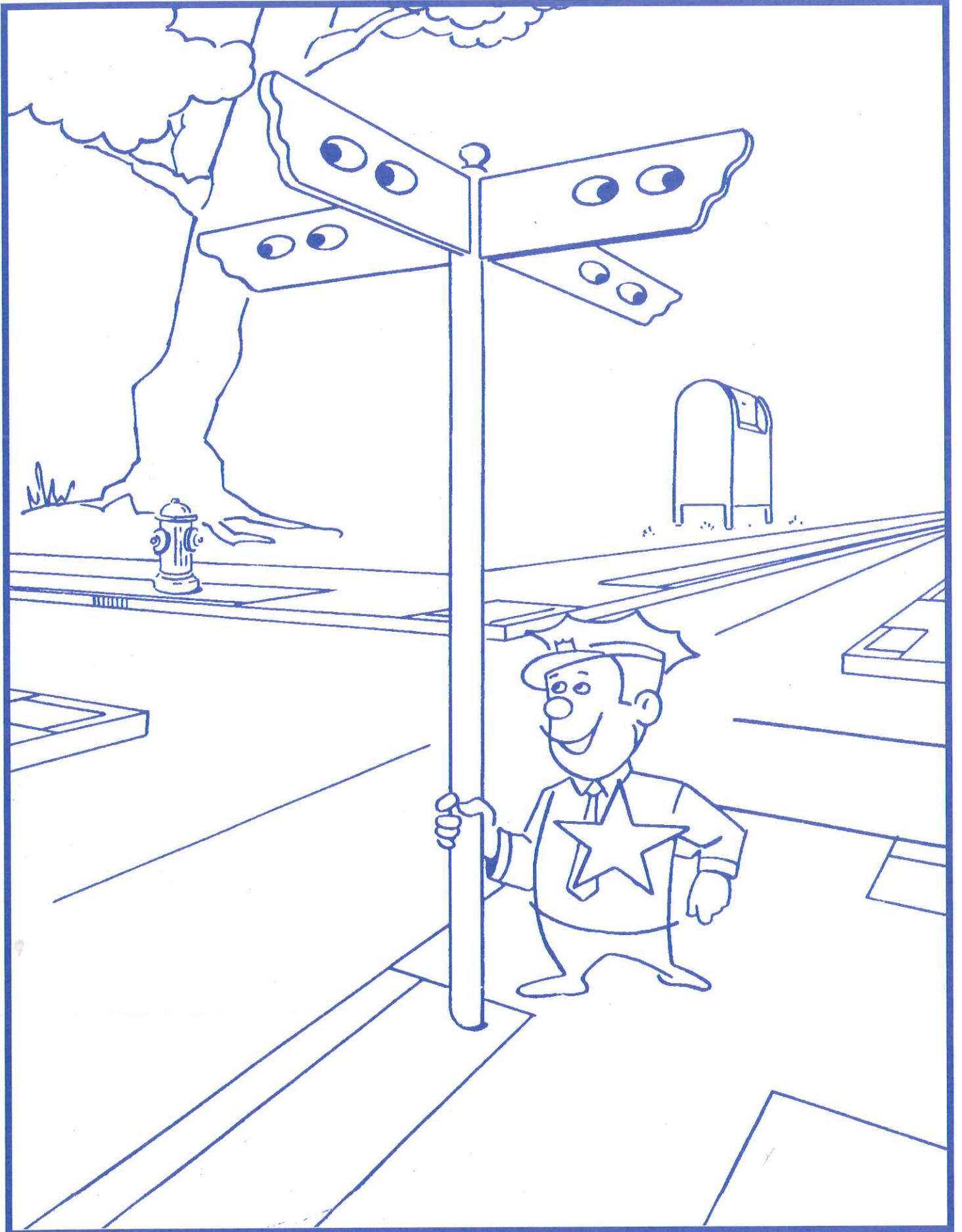
Safety Ed says: Policemen and Crossing Guards are your safety friends.



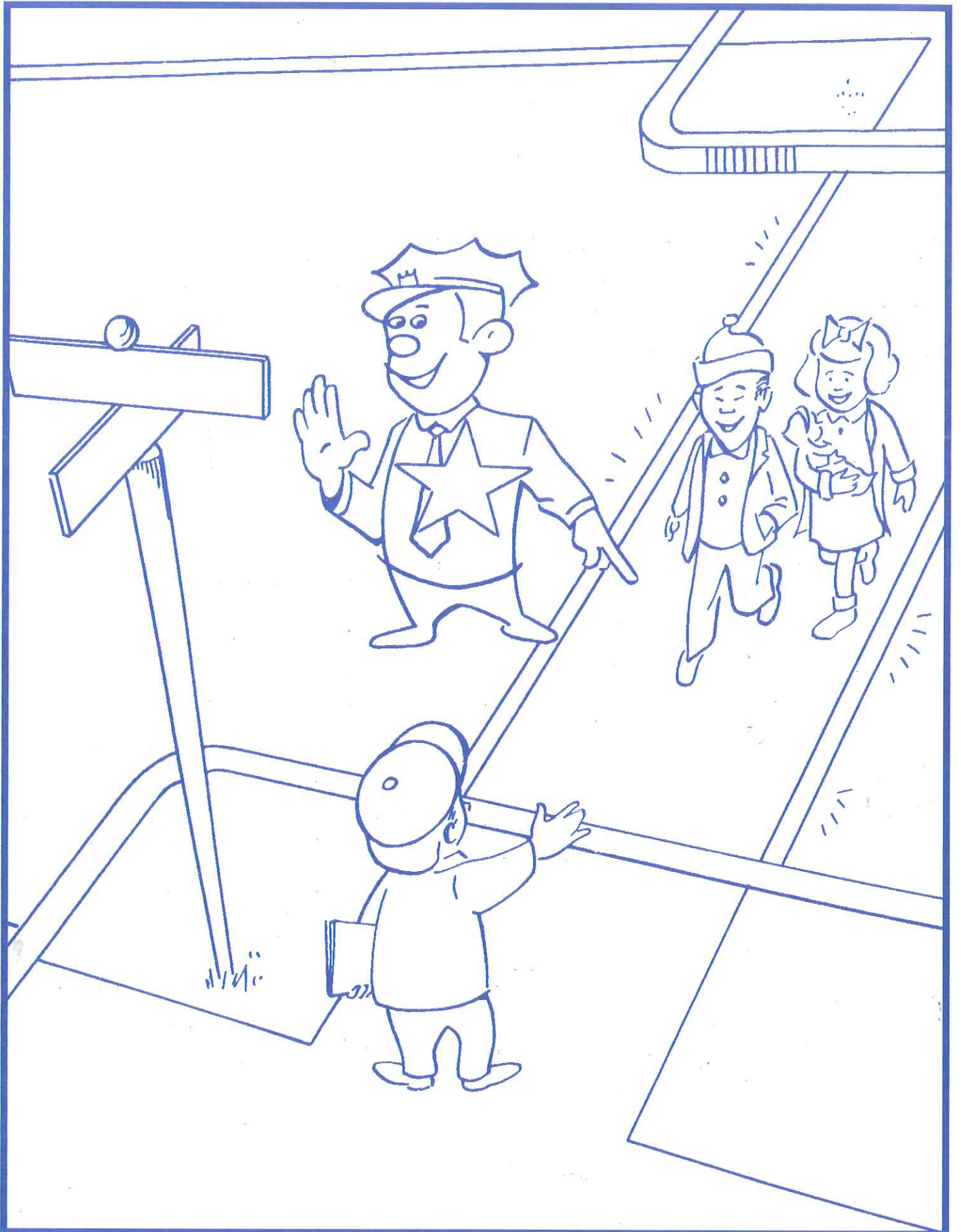
Safety Ed says: What do these street signs mean? Explain them.



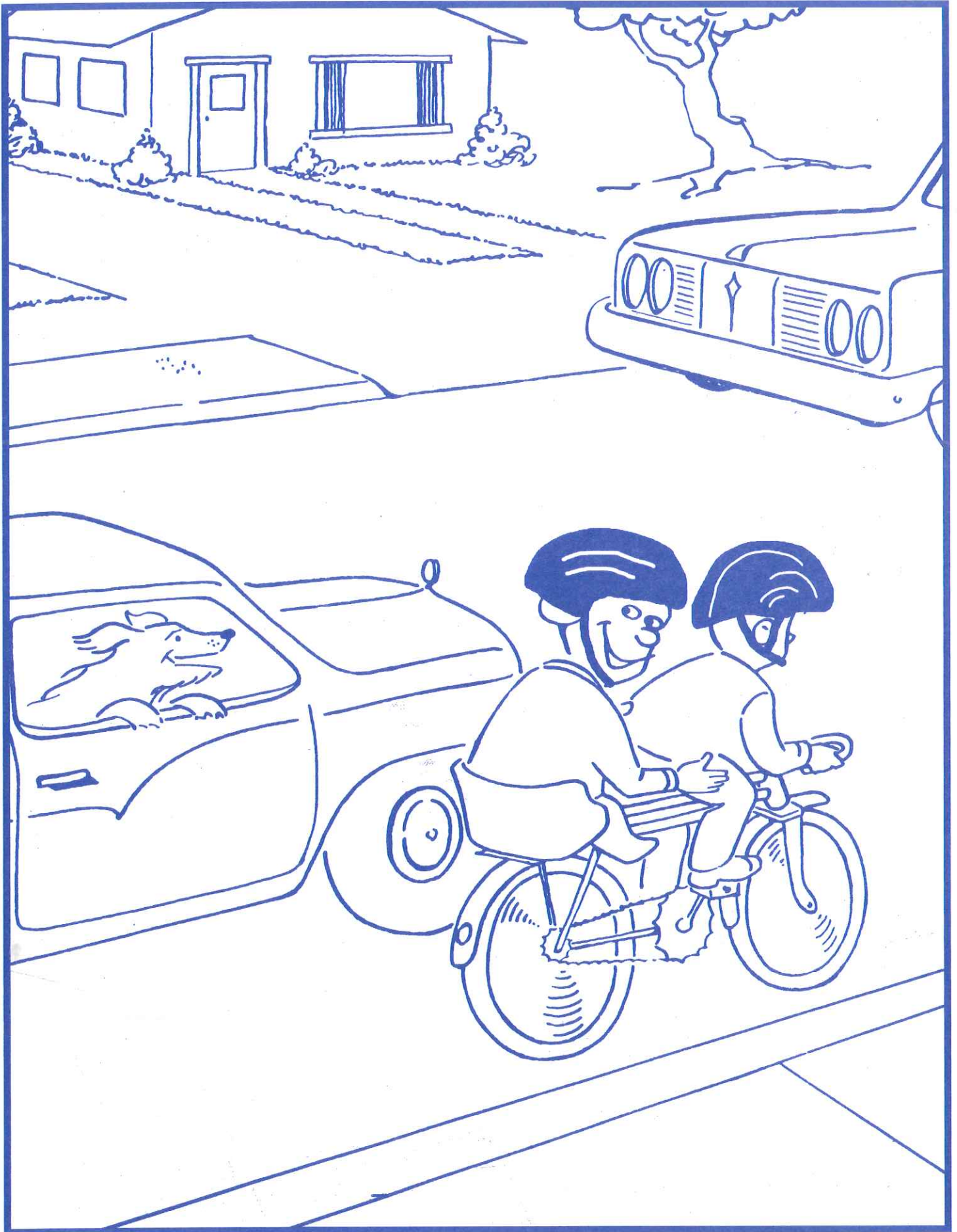
Safety Ed says: Always obey all traffic lights facing you.



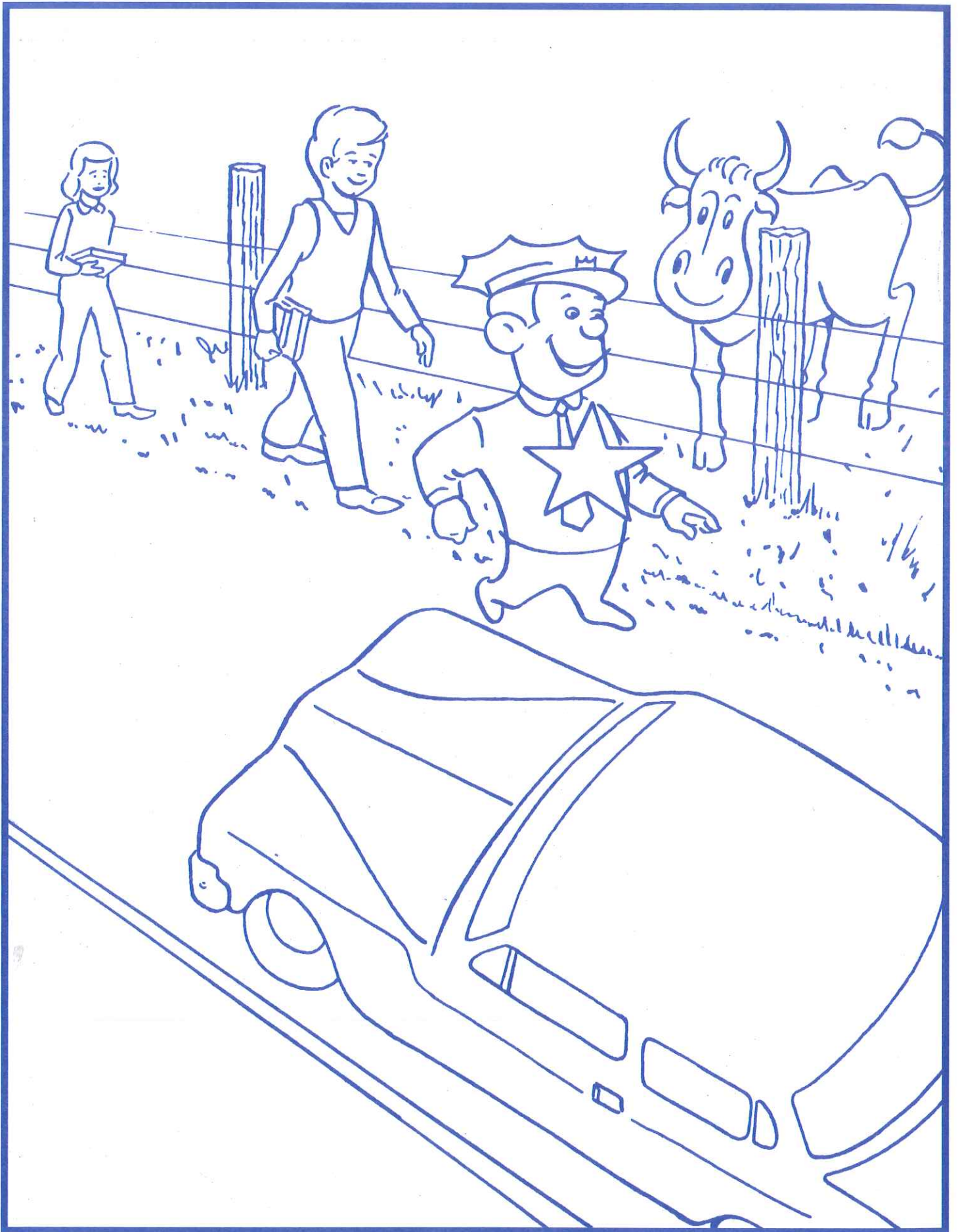
Safety Ed says: Always look all ways before crossing any street.



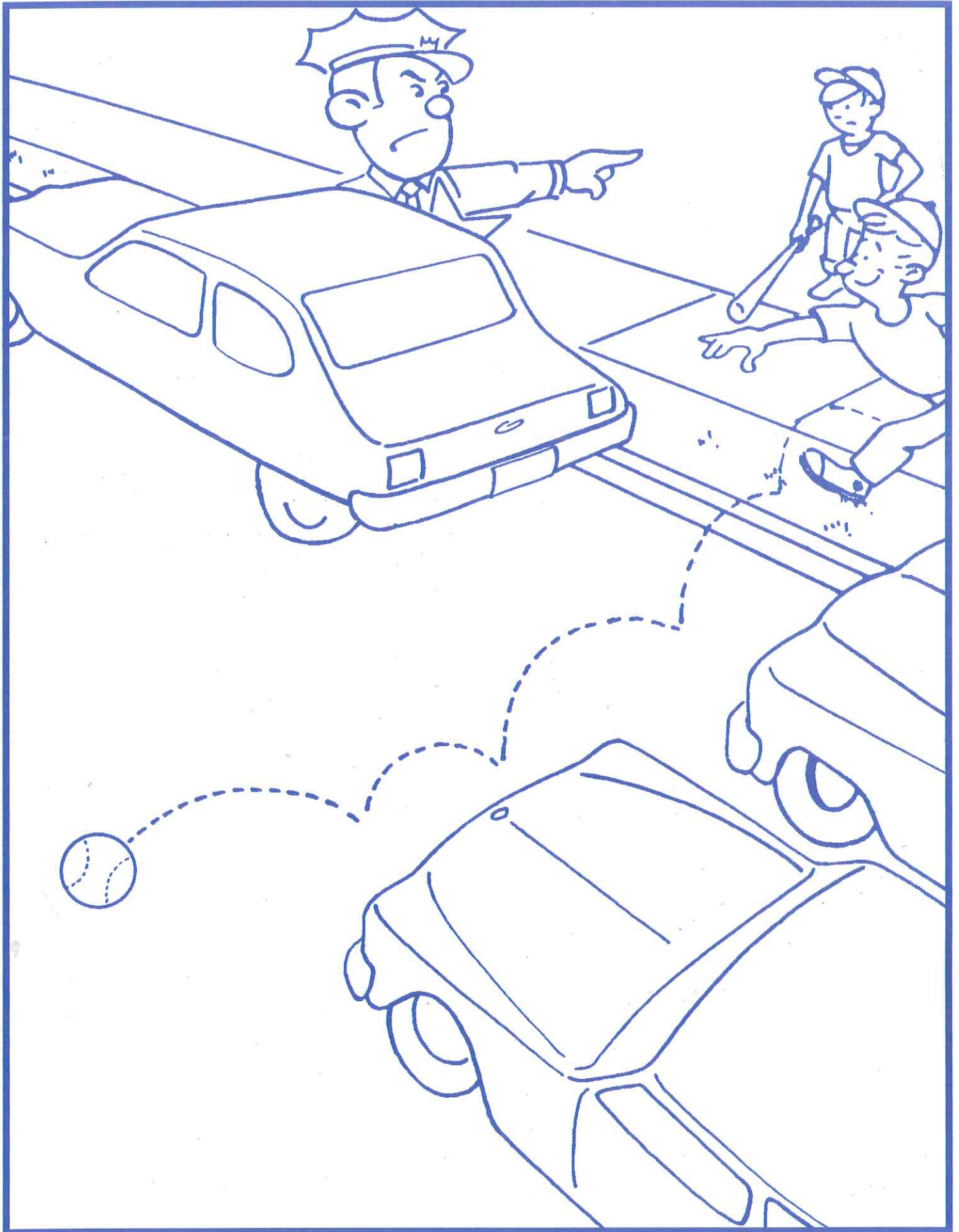
Safety Ed says: Always cross the street at corners between the white lines.



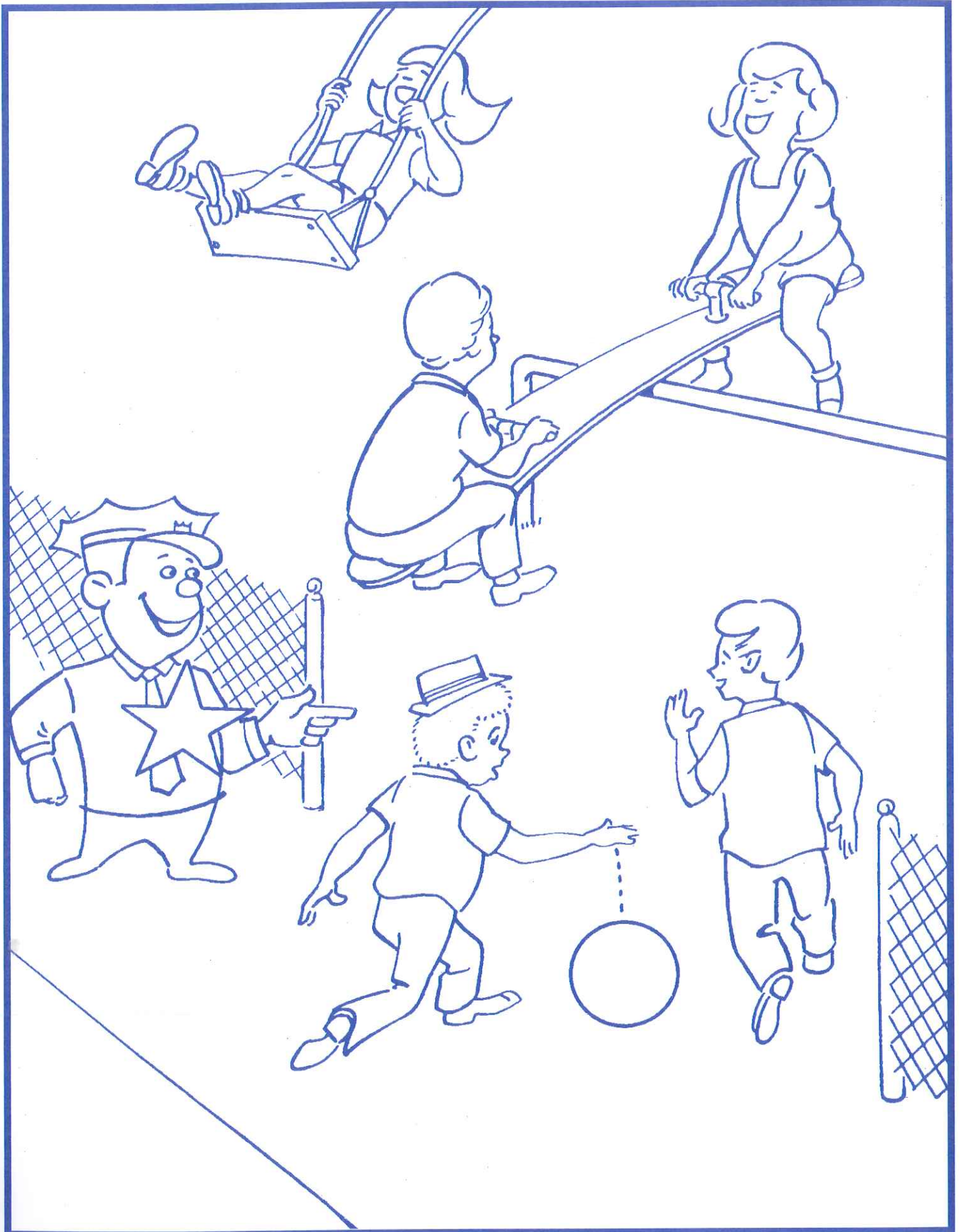
Safety Ed says: Always ride your bike on the right side of the street and wear protective gear.



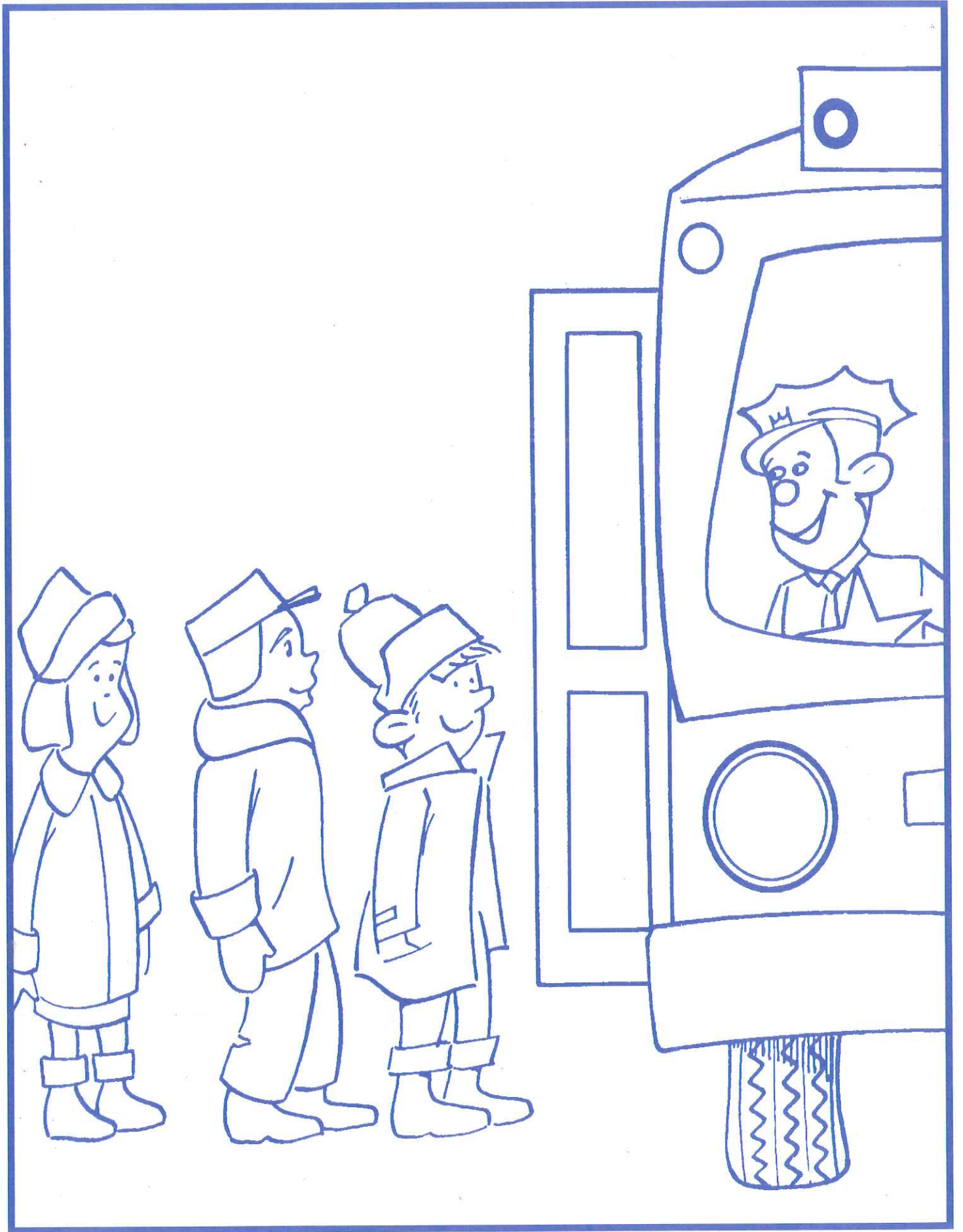
Safety Ed says: Where there is no sidewalk, always walk facing the driver.



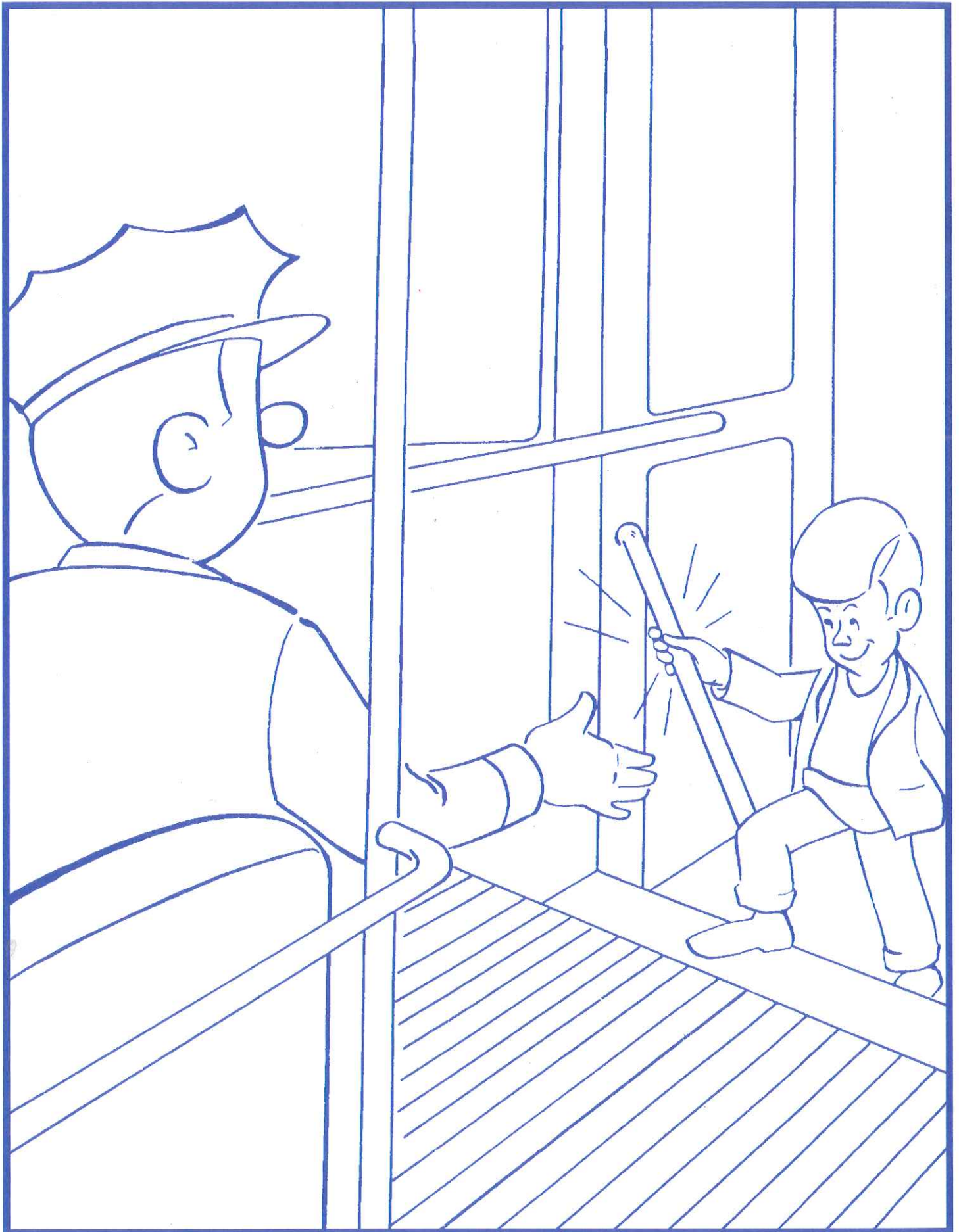
Safety Ed says: Never run between parked cars.



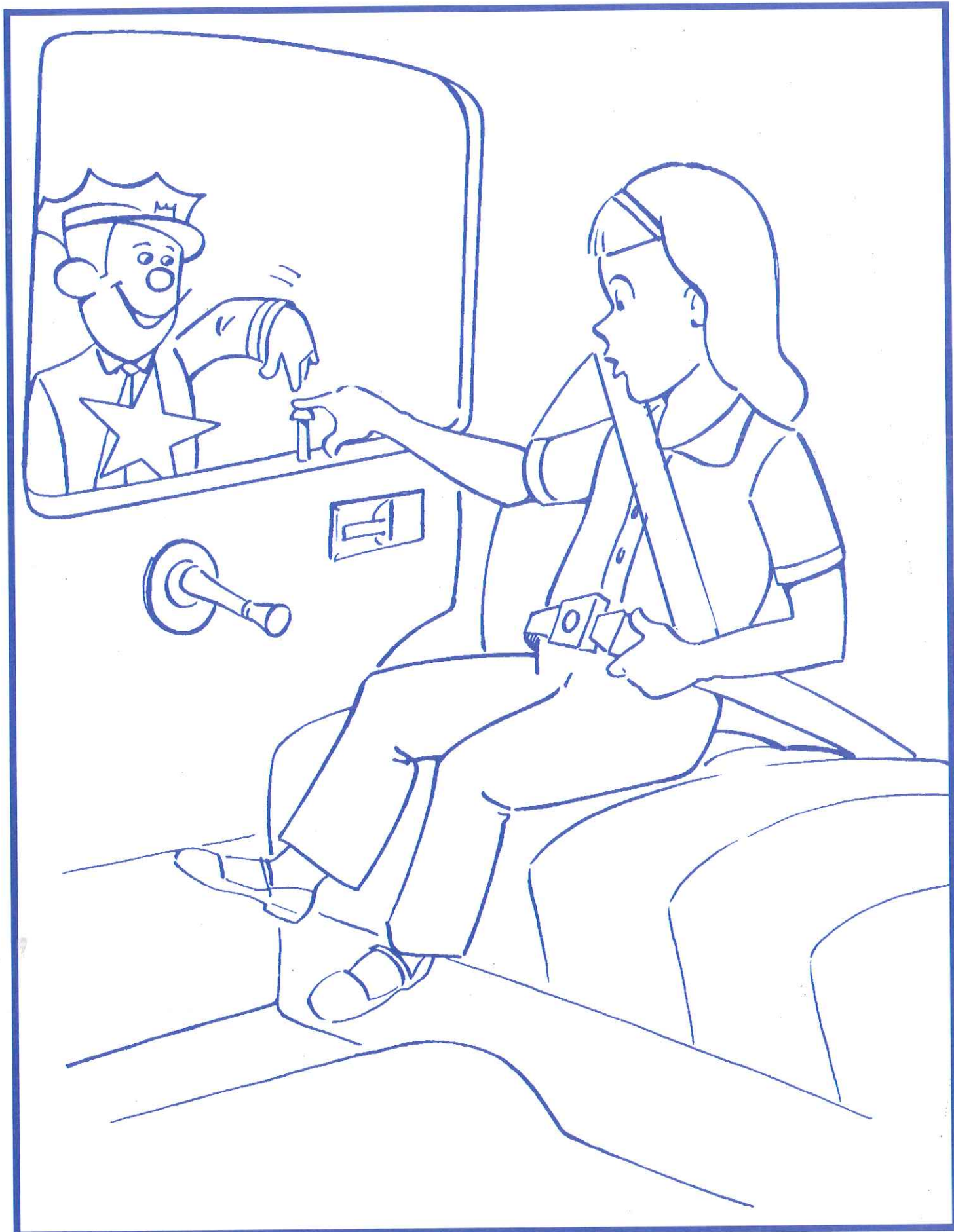
Safety Ed says: Always play in safe places.



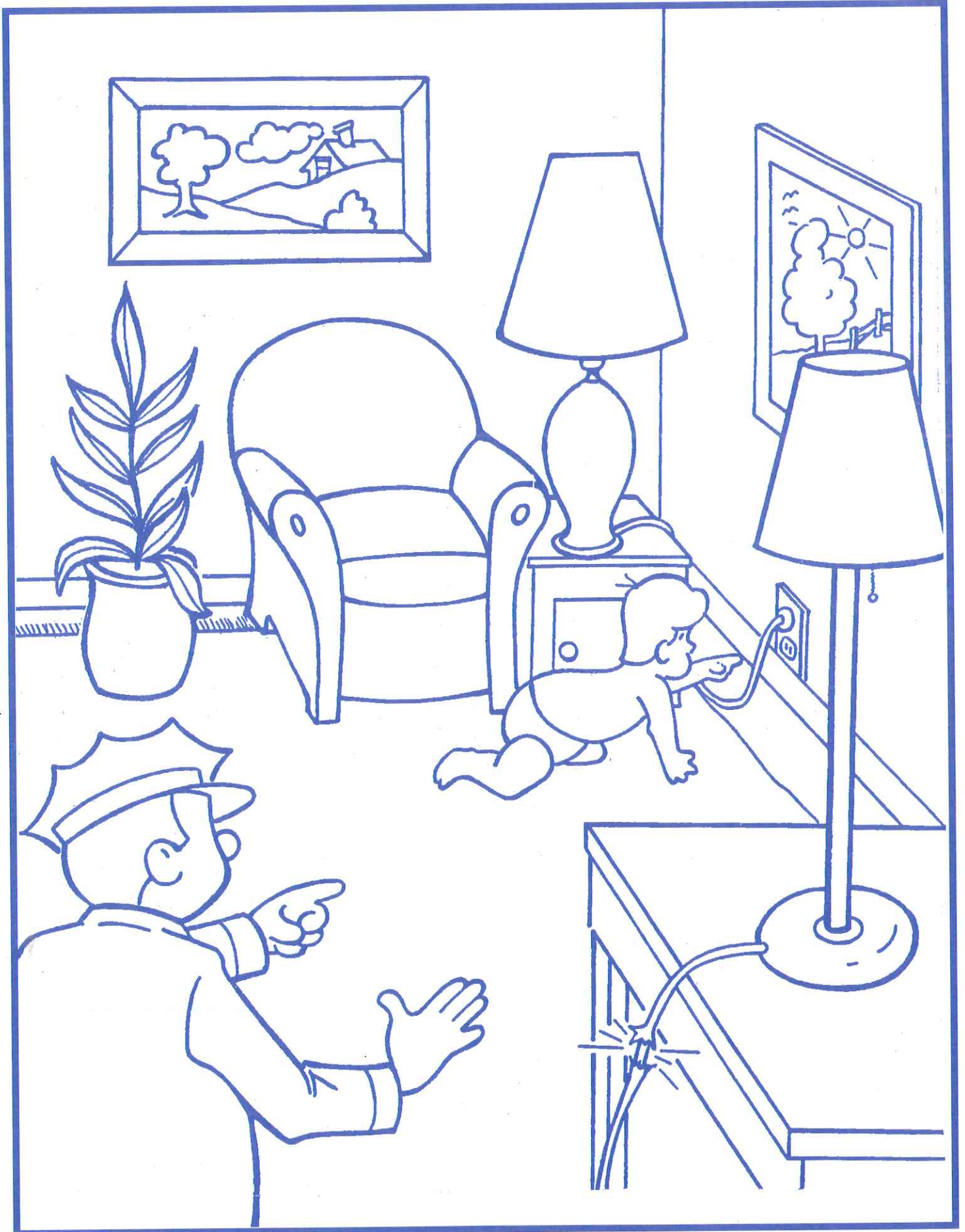
Safety Ed says: Always board the bus in single file, no pushing or shoving.
